## Free February at the NB Museum

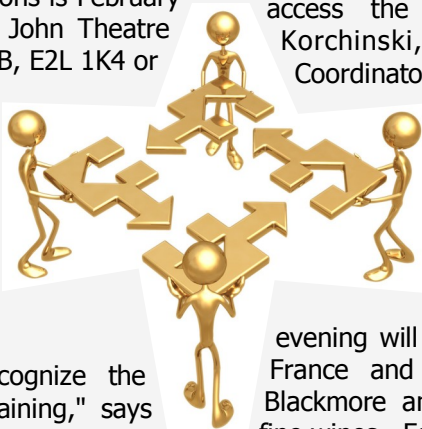
